### About this Masterclass

The Masterclass has been designed to illustrate how general scientific evidence and consensus statements on the management of Upper Gastrointestinal Cancer published in the medical literature can be applied to the management of complex and problematic individual patients as part of evidence-based cancer medicine. The Masterclass will open with a lecture on current (2005) thinking on the essential elements of an effective multi-disciplinary service for investigation and management, followed by the detailed discussion of 10 difficult and unusual clinical cases of upper GI cancer, each of which will generate a treatment decision/regimen recommended as best clinical practice for the given case.
